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ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM

ADULT EDUCATION

In cooperation with the Kansas Board of Regents, the Adult Education Program is designed to help adults increase knowledge and improve skills essential in today's world in four areas:

Basic Skills (ABE)

Classes enable adults to improve their skills in reading, writing, math, science, and social studies. Employability skills, including computer training, are also a part of the basic skills curriculum. These classes are open to all adults who wish to brush up on basic skills whether or not they have completed a high school diploma.

High School Equivalency Preparation (GED)

Classes prepare adults for all subjects on the GED test: math, language arts, social studies and science. These classes also strengthen writing skills and help students prepare to transition to college or careers after earning their GED. All Kansas residents who pass the GED Test are awarded a Kansas State High School Diploma.

College Preparation

Classes help strengthen math, reading and writing skills in order to prepare for the Accuplacer exam. Students also learn test-taking and study skills for success in post-secondary education.

English as a Second Language (ESL)

Classes enable adults with little or no knowledge of English to improve their speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in English. Citizenship and workplace skills are included in ESL curriculum.





Classes

Classes are held at the KCKCC campus and one satellite learning center at a variety of times to meet the needs of changing schedules. ABE, Pre-GED, GED and College Preparation classes are offered on KCKCC Main Campus in the Continuing Education Building and at the Pioneer Career Center in Leavenworth. ESL classes are held in the lower level Flint Building on main campus.

Registration


Persons 18 years of age or older may enroll in the program. Students who are 16 or 17 years old may enroll in the program after they withdraw from high school and receive disclaimer and exemption forms from the high school where they reside. To register for classes, please call 913-288-7660.

Orientation/Enrollment

Orientation consists of three sessions where students will learn about the program and do placement testing. The placement testing is done to help us customize your class needs. Orientations are held quarterly.

Cost

There is a \$60 fee (\$75 for ESL with OPD) to cover the cost of enrollment materials and supplies for all Adult Education classes each academic year. Fee is due at orientation payable by cash, check or money order.



GED TEST

The GED Test is the only high school equivalency credential recognized in Kansas. The test includes four sections in the subject areas of language arts, math, science and social studies. All Kansas residents who pass the GED Test are awarded a Kansas State High School Diploma.

A high school diploma can benefit a person's life by opening doors for further education as well as employment opportunities. It also benefits an individual personally by the confidence that is gained through setting and achieving goals and realizing one's potential to learn and grow.

The passing scores for the GED Test are:

- 145 Pass/High School Graduate
- 165 Pass/College Ready/Honors
- 175 Pass/College Ready + Credit

To sign up for a GED Test, please go to GED.com. You will need to set up an account, and the website will direct you with further instructions. You must be 18 years old. If you are 16 or 17 years old, you will need to officially withdraw from high school and participate in an exit interview with a parent or guardian. At that interview you will receive disclaimer and exemption forms that are needed to sign up for the GED Test. No one under the age of 16 may take the test. The GED Test is a computer based test, and Kansas City Kansas Community College is a GED testing site. If you would like to brush up on skills before taking the GED Test, please sign up for the Adult Education Program classes listed on the previous page.

The GED Test can be taken in English or Spanish. The fee for the entire test is \$132 or \$33 per section.

DRIVER SAFETY



Driver's Education

This course is designed for the beginning driver and consists of 28 hours of classroom instruction, six hours of driving with the instructor, and 12 hours of observation. During this state approved course, students will master Kansas road laws and safe defensive driving techniques. The instructor will arrange the driving and observation time after the class begins, and the entire 18 hours of driving and observation time will be outside the classroom instruction hours and may extend beyond the course completion date. The driving is scheduled on weekends during the school year and weekdays and weekends in the summer. To be eligible to take this class, the student must be 14 years of age or older. Upon completion of the test, a form will be given to the student to take to the State of Kansas Department of Motor Vehicles to obtain an Instructional Permit. Successful completion of the course requirements will result in a Certificate of Completion from the state. This Certificate may lead to the license the student is eligible to receive without further testing. However, the state does reserve the right to re-test. Upon completion, a Defensive Driving certificate will be issued that may be used for insurance discounts.

Driver's Education One Day Course plus **Drive Time**

This course is designed to give students the fundamentals for driving responsibly, safely and defensively. In addition to the 8 hour classroom portion, each student will receive for to six lessons of behind-the-wheel training that will be scheduled during the classroom portion but will begin the week following the class. Amount of drive time is determined by the instructor as the student achieves the driving competencies. Students must be at least 14 years old. It is recommended but not necessary for students to have a current learner's permit prior to the class. All course materials are included in the course fee. A welcome letter from the instructor and the Transportation division will be sent to enrolled participants approximately one week prior to the first class. For students under 18: We strongly recommend that a parent/guardian attend the first class to meet the instructor and complete forms. Driving lessons will be scheduled during the first class session. Driving will take place over the next 4-5 weeks. Expectations are that all students should complete the program during that 4-5 week time frame.

MOTORCYCLE TRAINING

Basic RiderCourse™

Learn how to operate a motorcycle safely with emphasis on the special skills and mental attitude necessary for dealing with traffic. In the classroom, you'll learn about the different types of motorcycles, their controls, how they operate and how to become a responsible rider. After a thorough review of your motorcycle controls, you will move to the outdoor riding range and your instructors will start you off with straight-line riding, turning, shifting, and stopping. You will gradually progress to cornering, swerving, and emergency braking. Motorcycles and helmets are provided. Students must ride our training motorcycles and wear the following protective gear while riding during the course: eye protection, full finger gloves, long pants (no baggies or flares), long sleeve shirt or jacket, sturdy shoes over the ankle or boots. Also, you must have a valid driver's license. Note: Safety is our primary concern. If safety becomes an issue during the class, RiderCoaches will require students to work on balance and coordination skills outside of the class and reschedule for a later class date. It is **strongly recommended** that participants practice riding a bicycle PRIOR to the class to refresh their balance and coordination.




